Winter Saturday League Additional Procedures & FAQs



In addition to the League Rules, the following procedures will be in place for the 2021/22 season, this is in line with EN recommendations and in consultation with the County Covid Officer:

- Each team will be responsible for sanitising hands, one goal post and ball(s)
- Players and umpires to sanitise hands before, after and during intervals for each game
- Post to be sanitised when contact made by a player, and instructed by the umpire – time to be held
- Normal scorecards to be used and umpires to enter their name, Membership ID and umpire qualification at the end of the game. They can ask the scorer to enter the information if they're not comfortable handling the scorecard

FAQs

Can you use the same scorecard for multiple scorers?

Yes you can but it is advised to just have 1 scorer

Do the umpire and scorer have to sign the scorecard?

No – names of officials should be printed on the scorecard. This can be written by the scorer

Can we share bibs?

It is advised to keep this to a minimum

Can we have spectators?

Yes you can but it's recommended to keep this to a minimum and for spectators to socially distance. They must remain outside the court area.

What if one of my team test positive for covid after playing a game?

Contact the County Covid Officer and League Secretary immediately, contact details below. Advise who the player is that has tested positive, the date/time of match and their opponents.
